Lindley will host the second Leta Lindley Prader-Willi Classic golf tournament that will feature a number of her friends from the LPGA Tour. It will be held on December 7th at the PGA National Resort and Spa in Palm Beach Gardens Florida. "As the mother of two children, I couldn't help but feel a connection to children in need," Lindley revealed. "I have always wanted to use my golf talents to make a difference and I never imagined that opportunity would present itself in this way."
